

HANCOCK PARK

Hancock Park is intended to be used primarily for walking, hiking, and with limited trails for mountain biking. There is a variety of trails, bridges, a pavilion, and view areas. Please use caution as some of the trails are steep with loose gravel.

- Hancock Park hours are from dusk to dawn
- Park is open to residents and members of Rollins Ranch HOA
- No motorized vehicles (gas or electric)
- Adult should supervise all children
- No fires at any time ever
- No overnight loitering or camping unless approved by owner.
- Pack out what you pack in – remove all trash – DO NOT LITTER!
- Please keep dogs on leash while on trails (ok to unleash at creek bottom area as long as not disturbing others)

Entry and use of the Hancock Park is at your own risk. There are many risks and natural hazards including but not limited to: mountain lions, bears, porcupines, snakes, insects, allergens, uneven and steep terrain, loose rocks, various water hazards, high creek runoff, strong currents, flooding, and extreme temperatures.
